To find the co-ordinate of a square ( a four figure co-ordinate) we read

## Across then Up



The number you get ( 3161 ) is called a four figure grid reference. It lets you find any square on the map. Each square has its own number (its own grid reference). On the map above each square is 1 km by 1 km , which is quite a big area.
